JA Take Stock in Your Future introduces students to basic concepts about how the stock market works and the impact of current events on the stock market. Through **JA Take Stock in Your Future**, students discover the benefits and challenges of investing in the stock market as part of a broader, long-term investment strategy and the risks and rewards of trading.

After completing the classroom curriculum, students and teachers are invited to compete in the **JA Stock Market Challenge**, where high school students compete by investing and trading fake funds in the real market, creating draft portfolios as teams, and finalizing their stock selections.
